MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF LINCOLN AVENUE AND THE COYOTE CREEK CROSSING, 40 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF LINCOLN AVENUE AND 8 FT. EASTERLY OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS SET 1.0 FT. BELOW THE ROAD.
