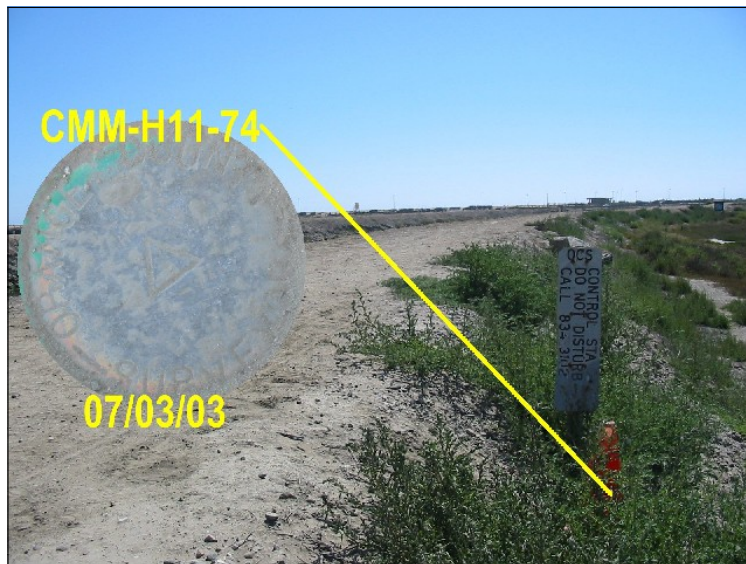

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "CMM-H11-74", SET IN THE TOP OF A 20 IN. DIAMETER CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHERLY LEVEE OF THE GARDEN GROVE WINTERSBURG CHANNEL, 1.25 MILES WESTERLY ALONG THE NORTHERLY LEVEE ROAD FROM THE CENTERLINE OF GRAHAM STREET, 9.6 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE LEVEE AND 2.8 FT. EASTERLY OF AN OCS STEEL PADDLEBOARD WITNESS POST. MONUMENT IS SET 1.5 FT. LOWER THAN THE LEVEE ROAD.
