DESCRIBED BY OCS 2004 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "D 350 1949", SET IN THE TOP OF A 1 FT. BY 1 FT. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED 1.15 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG BREA BOULEVARD FROM THE INTERSECTION OF STATE COLLEGE BOULEVARD TO A PAVED ROAD WITH STEEL GATE LEADING EASTERLY, 1250 FT. EASTERLY ALONG THE PAVED ROAD, 35 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD AND 4 FT. WESTERLY OF A 24 IN. DIAMETER ELM TREE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE ROAD.
