### Description:

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "E 313 1935", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF ORTEGA HIGHWAY (RTE 74), 12.6 MILES EASTERLY ALONG ORTEGA FROM THE CENTERLINE OF INTERSTATE 5 FREEWAY TO THE SAN JUAN FIRE STATION, 104.7 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF ORTEGA, 15.1 FT. EASTERLY OF POWER POLE (#P128463) AND AN OCS WITNESS POST 1.6 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE MONUMENT. MONUMENT IS SET UP 2.2 FT. ABOVE THE PARKING AREA IN A RAISED MEDIAN.
