DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "HB-210-71", SET IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE OVER A FLOOD CONTROL CHANNEL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERLY LEVEE OF THE GARDEN GROVE WINTERSBURG CHANNEL, 0.7 MILES WESTERLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY LEVEE FROM THE CENTERLINE OF GRAHAM STREET AND 12.5 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS SET 0.2 FT. ABOVE THE BRIDGE DECK.
