DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY BRONZED DISK STAMPED "J 351 1949", SET IN THE TOP OF A 1 FT. BY 1 FT. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF BREA BOULEVARD, 0.65 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG BREA FROM ITS INTERSECTION OF STATE COLLEGE/CENTRAL TO A DIRT ROAD, 11 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE SAID DIRT ROAD, 90 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE NORTHERLY END OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE OVER BREA CREEK AND 33 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BREA. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE GROUND.
