DESCRIBED BY OCS 2004 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "L 784 1946", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHEASTERLY SIDE OF OLD EL TORO ROAD WHICH IS NOW A BIKE PATH, 0.3 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG BIKE PATH FROM THE CENTERLINE OF THE NORTHBOUND FOOTHILL TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR, 32 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE BIKE PATH AND 5 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF A 16 IN. DIAMETER TREE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE GROUND.
