DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" USGS BRONZE DISK STAMPED "N 766 1945", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE ABUTMENT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, 0.35 MILES SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF SEAL BEACH BOULEVARD, 0.5 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF THE NORTHWEST END OF THE BRIDGE OVER THE US NAVAL WEAPONS DEPOT. MONUMENT IS SET 1.0 FT. ABOVE PCH.
