DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "N 781 1946", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH STREET AND OLIVE STREET, 28 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF SOUTH STREET, 30 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD THAT RUNS ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF OLIVE STREET AND 1.3 FT. WESTERLY OF A POWER POLE (#22915D). MONUMENT IS SET 0.1 FT. BELOW THE SIDEWALK.
