DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" NGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "N 784 1946", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF EL TORO ROAD, 3.6 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG EL TORO FROM THE CENTERLINE OF THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA SANTA FE RAILWAY, 66.2 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF EL TORO, 45 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF AN ASPHALT ACCESS ROAD LEADING TO THE NORTH, 28.8 FT. SOUTHERLY OF AN ASPHALT BIKE PATH AND IN LINE WITH A LARGE ROW OF EUCALYPTUS TREES. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE GRADE.
