REPORTED DESTROYED (SEE DATE IN DESTROYED BOX) - ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION BEING: RECOVERY NOTE BY NATIONAL GEODETIC SURVEY 1988 IN SAN CLEMENTE, AT THE FT. OF CALAFIA AVENUE, IN TOP OF THE NORTHWEST END OF THE SOUTHWEST HEADWALL OF A DOUBLE BARREL 48 INCH CONCRETE CULVERT UNDER THE ATCHISON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY, 51.2 METERS (168 FT.) NORTHWEST AND ACROSS THE RAILROAD TRACK FROM SIGNAL 206.2, 3 METERS (9.8 FT.) SOUTHWEST OF THE SOUTHWEST RAIL. THE STATION IS 0.7 METER BELOW THE HEIGHT OF THE TRACKS. NOTE-- THE DISK IS PARTIALLY COVERED BY A RAILROAD TIE BUT THE HIGH POINT IS STILL ACCESSIBLE.
