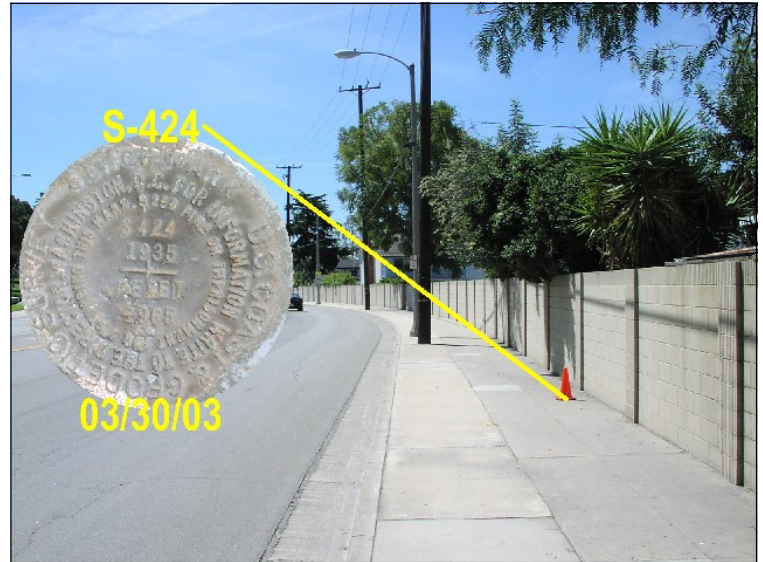

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY BRONZED DISK STAMPED "S-424-R65", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE SIDEWALK. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF CLOVE DRIVE PROLONGED TO THE EAST AND BREA BOULEVARD, 47 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BREA AND 106 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF CLOVE PROJECTED TO THE EAST. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
