DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY BRONZED DISK, STAMPED "U-348", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF BREA BOULEVARD, 0.8 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG BREA FROM THE INTERSECTION OF TONNER CANYON ROAD, 43 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BREA AND 165 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF BENCHMARK (#V-348). MONUMENT IS SET 6 FT. BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE.
