DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "U 779 1946", SET IN THE EASTERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL FOR A BOX CULVERT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF A SINGLE SET OF RAILROAD TRACKS, 0.25 MILES EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BEACH BOULEVARD ALONG THE RAILWAY, 88 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE RAILWAY AND 0.5 FT. WESTERLY OF THE EASTERLY END OF THE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS SET 14 FT. BELOW THE LEVEL OF THE TRACKS.
