MONUMENT IS** LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF NEWPORT BOULEVARD, AT THE PROJECTED **INTERSECTION OF 15TH STREET AND NEWPORT BOULEVARD, 54 SOUTHERLY OF THE PROLONGED CENTERLINE OF 15TH STREET AND 63 FT.** SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE EAST CURB OF THE CENTER MEDIAN ALONG NEWPORT BOULEVARD.
