MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF NEWPORT BOULEVARD, AT THE PROJECTED INTERSECTION OF 15TH STREET AND NEWPORT BOULEVARD, 54 SOUTHERLY OF THE PROLONGED CENTERLINE OF 15TH STREET AND 63 FT.
