DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY BRONZED DISK STAMPED "V-348", SET IN THE TOP OF A 1 FT. BY 1 FT. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF BREA BOULEVARD, 0.75 MILES NORTHEASTERLY OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH TONNER CANYON ROAD, 33 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BREA, 165 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF A BENCHMARK (#U-348) AND 85 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF BENCHMARK (#W-348). MONUMENT IS SET 5 FT. BELOW THE LEVEL OF THE ROAD.
