DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY BRONZED DISK STAMPED "X-423", SET IN THE TOP OF A 4 IN. BY 4 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF BREA BOULEVARD, 0.85 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG BREA FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH STATE COLLEGE/CENTRAL, 20 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BREA AND 85 FT. WESTERLY OF BENCHMARK (#B-351). MONUMENT IS SET 1 FT. ABOVE THE GROUND.
