DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" USC&GS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "X 785 1946", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF LAGUNA CANYON ROAD (STATE HIGHWAY 133), 0.61 MILES SOUTHERLY ALONG LAGUNA CANYON ROAD FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH LAGUNA ROAD, 38 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF LAGUNA CANYON ROAD, 6 FT. NORTHERLY OF AN 18 INCH DIAMETER TREE WITH LARGE CANOPY, 22 FT. WESTERLY OF A 4 FT. TALL BARBED WIRE FENCE AND 19.3 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF THE WESTERLY END OF A 12 INCH CORRUGATED METAL PIPE CULVERT. MONUMENT IS SET 1.5 FT. ABOVE THE ROAD- NOTE - MARK IS LOCATED UNDER A LARGE TREE CANOPY.
