DESCRIBED BY OCS 1968 0.5 OF A MILE SOUTHEAST ALONG THE PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY (U.S. 101 ALT) FROM THE NEWPORT AVENUE OVERPASS AT NEWPORT BEACH, 0.1 OF A MILE NORTHWEST OF A CLIFF ON THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY, AT PORT ORANGE FISHING HOLE, 28 FT. SOUTHEAST OF THE PROLONGATION OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE SOUTHEAST ONE OF TWO PAVED ENTRANCE ROADS, IN THE TOP OF THE CONCRETE SEA WALL, 72 YARDS SOUTHWEST OF THE SOUTHWEST CURB OF THE HIGHWAY, 26.0 FT. WEST OF THE WEST CORNER OF A WHITE PAINTED ICEHOUSE, 2.2 FT. SOUTHWEST OF THE EAST (OUTSIDE) CORNER OF A RIGHT ANGLE IN THE SEA WALL, 1.5 FT. SOUTHWEST OF A 14 INCH POST SUPPORTING A ROPE GUARDRAIL AND ABOUT LEVEL WITH THE GROUND.
