DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" USC&GS BRONZE DISK STAMPED "Z 167 1933", SET IN THE TOP OF A 4 FT. BY 4 FT. CONCRETE PAD. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, 0.25 MILES SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BEACH BOULEVARD, 81 FT.
