DESCRIBED BY OCS 2013 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "Z 312 1935", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHWESTERLY SIDE OF ORTEGA HIGHWAY, 2.2 MILES EASTERLY ALONG ORTEGA FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ANTONIO PARKWAY. 14 FT. EASTERLY OF A SMALL CULVERT, 8.8 FT. NORTHWESTERLY FROM THE FACE OF AN OAK TREE, AND 1.5 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF AN OCS PADDLEBOARD. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE GROUND.
