DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "Z 784 1946", SET IN THE SOUTHERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF THE ATCHINSON/TOPEKA/SANTA FE RAILWAY, 0.5 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG THE RAILWAY FROM THE OVERCROSSING OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY AND 11.2 FT. EASTERLY OF THE EASTERLY RAIL. MONUMENT IS SET 0.2 FT. BELOW THE LEVEL OF THE TRACKS.
