of wires thereon for power, light, telephone or telegraph; to construct and maintain pipe lines or conduits for conducting therein, water, gas, oil and its products, storm waters or sewage, together with the right to convey to others one or more or all of said easements, over, under and across the above described Parcels "B" and "C" within a strip of land 34 feet in width, the center line of which is parallel with and 950.00 feet easterly, measured at right angles, from the westerly line of said Parcel No. 61.

- 2. Said Grantor agrees that it will not perform or arrange for the performance of any construction or reconstruction work over, under and across the above mentioned 34-foot wide strip of land, until the plans and specifications for such construction or reconstruction shall have first been submitted to and been approved in writing by the Chief Engineer of Los Angeles County Flood Control District.
- 3. It is expressly understood that Los Angeles County Flood Control District will not be called upon to construct, reconstruct or repair any of the facilities that may be used as provided in the above reserved easements.
- that it will indemnify and save harmless Los Angeles County Flood Control District, its officers, agents and/or employees, from any and all liability, loss or damage which said District, its officers,

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agents and/or employes may suffer by reason of the exercise of any of the above reserved easements.

5. The provisions and agreements contained in this Grant Deed shall be binding upon said Grantor, its successors and assigns.
