RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF

ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

June 25, 1974

On motion of Supervisor Diedrich, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the State of California, on July 14, 1971, accepted the improvements on FAS project 1279(7) on Santiago Canyon Road between 3.5 miles north of Live Oak Canyon Road and 0.4 miles south of Silverado Canyon Road;

WHEREAS, this road was realigned and the old alignment has been superseded by the new construction and new right of way;

WHEREAS, on August 19, 1969, the County agreed with The Irvine Company to initiate the abandonment of 4,349 acres of superseded right of way;

WHEREAS, this Board does hereby find and determine that it is desirable and in the public interest that said portion of the County road so superseded be abandoned;

WHEREAS, this Board does hereby find and determine that such abandonment will not cut off all access to the property of any person which, prior to relocation, adjoined the highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does hereby order the abandonment of the hereafter described road effective upon the recordation of a certified copy hereof with the Recorder of Orange County. Said property is described as follows:

Those portions of Santiago Canyon Road as described in a deed recorded in Book 561, Page 262, Official Records of Orange County, California, which lie within Blocks 146, 148 and 149 of Irvine's Subdivision as shown on a map recorded in Book 1, Page 88 of Miscellaneous Maps, Records of said County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM that portion of said Santiago Canyon Road lying Northwesterly of a radial line passing through the Northerly terminus of a curve in the center line of said Santiago Canyon Road as described in said deed recorded in Book 561, Page 262 of Official Records

as having a radius of 350.00 feet, a central angle of 39° 38' 00" and an arc length of 242.11 feet.

ALSO EXCEPTING THEREFROM those portions included within the realignment of Santiago Canyon Road as described in Parcels 239, 239.3, 239.5 and 239.6 of the deed recorded in Book 9063, Page 900; Parcels 245 and 245.1 of the deed recorded in Book 9048, Page 866 and in Parcel 246 of the deed recorded in Book 9171, Page 479, all of Official Records of said County.

Reserving and excepting from this abandonment an easement or easements and right to maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew all now existing sanitary sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon and over the said highway and all portions thereof, and pursuant to any existing franchise or renewal thereof to maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge all now existing lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines, railroad lines, and for the transportation or distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, ammonia, water, and for incidental purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this action includes an express finding that this project is categorically exempt from compliance with E.I.R. procedures adopted pursuant to Resolution 74-237.
