Supervisor Wm. Schumacher arrives and assumes his duties as Supervisor. IN RE: DEED OF RIGHT OF WAY (SILVERADO CANYON ROAD).

On motion of Supervisor Smith duly seconded and carried Deed of Right of Way from The Irvine Company in the Fourth Road District Orange County, California, was duly accepted and declared a public highway which said roadis more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land sixty (50) feet in width and being thirty (30) feet oneach side of the following described center line:

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 28th day of June, 1932, by and between THE IRVINE COMPANY, a corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of West Virginia, hereinafter called the Grantor, the party of the first part, and the COUNTY OF ORANGE in the State of California, hereinafter called the Grantee, the party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable consideration, does hereby grant unto the said party of the second part, the right of way for a public highway, over all the right, title and interest of the party of the first part in and to that real property situate in the County of Orange, in the State of California, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The side lines of said strip of land shall be shortened or lengthened to intersect with Ranch line at the end of the description.

For the considerations named above, we hereby grant to the COUNTY OF ORANGE, the privilege and right to extend drainage structures and excavation and embankment slopes beyond the limits of the above described strips of Right of Way where required for the construction and maintenance of said Highway. Said embankment slopes to be 1 1/2: 1 slopes and said excavation slopes to be 1: 1 slopes.

The above described Right of Way is particularly shown on the accompanying Map which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

It is expressly understood that said grant of right of way is for the sole and exclusive purpose of ordinary travel as and upon a public highway, and is not intended, nor shall the same be used for railroad, telegraph, or telephone purposes or electric power lines, and all right, title and interest in and to the said right of way for every other purpose than that of a public highway is hereby reserved.

It is further understood and agreed between the parties hereto that the Grantor, its successors or assigns, shall at all times, and from time to time, hereafter have the right and

hereby reserves the right to construct, maintain and operate lines of any and all kinds across, under or over said roads, or any part thereof, and to construct, maintain and use, at any time or from time to time private road crossin's at reasonable place or places, and the right, to any time or from time to time, to construct, maintain and use crossings of any and all kinds of lines as aforesaid, including lines for the conveyance of water, and including lines for telephone, telegraph, electric power and railroads, but so as not to interfere with the natural flow ordrainage of storm waters, with the express understanding, however, that in case of the construction hereafter by the said Grantor, its successors or assigns, or any such pipe or other line across any road which at he time shall be improved with concrete, petrolithic or other hard surface, the same shall be do on or bored into or under such paved surface in such a manner, so far as possible, as to not injure the surface. If the surface of the road be injured or destroyed by such construction, then the same shall be replaced without charge to the Grantes. And in case of the construction of any such pipe or other line across any of said roads which at the time shall not be improved with a hard surface, the opening made to lay the pipe or other construction shall be properly filled up and tamped down and the surface of the road left uninjured.




