

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA.

January 25, 1947.

On motion of Supervisor Gordon, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED that Deed of Right of Way dated January 24th, 1947, from WILLIAM S. MILLER to the COUNTY OF ORANGE to widen and improve a portion of that certain highway commonly known as Silverado Canyon Road, a public purpose, covering the following described property, to-wit:

An irregular shaped parcel of land lying Northerly of and adjacent to the Right of Way for Silverado Canyon Road as shown on a Map of Tract No. 1167, recorded in Book 36, Pages 41 and 42, Miscellaneous Maps, Records of Orange County, California, and being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most Westerly corner of Lot 20, said Tract No. 1167, and running thence Westerly, along the Northeastly line of the Right of Way of Silverado Canyon Road as shown on said Map of Tract No. 1167, 3.49 feet to a point of reverse curvature and the beginning of a curve concave Southwesterly and having a radius of 144.95 feet; thence, Northwestly along said curve through a central angle of  $31^{\circ} 38' 00''$ , 80.03 feet to a point; a radial line to said curve at said point bears N.  $23^{\circ} 05' 00''$  E. thence, leaving said curve, S.  $66^{\circ} 55' 00''$  E. 99.66 feet to a point in the Northwestly line of said Lot 20, which said point is distant Easterly, measured along said Northwestly line, 31.12 feet from the most Westerly corner of said Lot 20; thence, S.  $64^{\circ} 35' 33''$  W., along said Northwestly line of Lot 20, 31.12 feet to the most Westerly corner of said Lot 20 and the point of beginning.

DEED OF RIGHT OF WAY  
SILVERADO CANYON ROAD

STATE OF CALIFORNIA )

County of Orange ) ss WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Orange County, California, to widen and improve a portion of that certain highway commonly known as SILVERADO CANYON ROAD, in the Fourth Road District; and WHEREAS, the necessary Right of Way for said widening and improvement is more particularly described as follows, to-wit. Approved as to Description Jan. 25, 1947

An irregular shaped parcel of land lying Northerly of and adjacent to the Right of Way for Silverado Canyon Road as shown on a Map of Tract No. 1167, recorded in Book 36, Pages 41 and 42, Miscellaneous Maps, Records of Orange County, California, and being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most westerly corner of Lot 20 said Tract No. 1167, and running thence Westerly, along the Northeastly line of the Right of Way of Silverado Canyon Road as shown on said Map of Tract No. 1167, 3.49 feet to a point of reverse curvature and the beginning of a curve concave Southwesterly and having a radius of 144.95 feet; thence, Northwestly along said curve through a central angle of  $31^{\circ} 38' 00''$ , 80.03 feet to a point; a radial line to said curve at said point bears N.  $23^{\circ} 05' 00''$  E., thence, leaving said curve S.  $66^{\circ} 55' 00''$  E. 99.66 feet to a point in the Northwestly line of said Lot 20, which said point is distant Easterly, measured along said Northwestly line, 31.12 feet from the most Westerly corner of said Lot 20; thence, S.  $64^{\circ} 35' 33''$  W. along said Northwestly line of Lot 20, 31.12 feet to the most Westerly corner of said Lot 20 and the point of beginning.

All as particularly shown on the accompanying Map which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the widening and improvement of said highway as above described, and of the benefits to accrue to us and each of us, by such widening and improvement, we the undersigned, owners, occupants and claimants of land required for highway

purposes on the line of the foregoing designated route, hereby signify our approval of the widening and improvement of said highway, and do hereby consent thereto; and do hereby grant and dedicate the lands belonging to us, and each of us, so far as the same may be required for such highway, to said Orange County, to that purpose, and for the use of such highway, and we hereby waive all claim for damages for and on account of the same.
