RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFCRNIA. January 26, 1947.

On motion of Supervisor Gorden, duly seconded and carried, the following Regolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED that Deed of Right of Way dated January 24th, 1947, from William B. FILLIR to the GOUNTY OF CRANGE to widen and improve a portion of that certain highest commonly known as Silverado Canyon Road, a public purpose, covering the following described property, to-wit:

An irregular shaped parcel of land lying Northerly of and adjacent to the Right of Way for Silverado Canyon Road as shows on a Kap of Tract No. 1167, recorded in Book 36, Pages 41 and 42, Miscellaneous Maps, Records of Orange County, Salifornia, and being particularly described as follows:

Paginning at the most Westerly corner of Lot 20, said fract No.167, and comming thence Westerly, along the Sertimensterly line of the Right of May of Silvernic Convention and as shown on said Map of Treat No.1167, 3.49 feet to a point of reverse curvature and the beginsts of a curve concave Southwesterly and having a radius of 144.95 feet; thence, Northwesterly along said curve through a central angle of 31% 38, 00% 20.03 feet to a point; a radial line to said curve at said point bears N. 23° 05' 00% X, thence, leaving said curve, S. 56° 55' 00% S. 99.66 feet to a point in the Northwesterly line of said lot 20, which said point is distant Easterly, measured along said Northwesterly line, 31.12 feet from the next Westerly corner of said Lot 20; thence, S. 54° 75' 33" W., along said Northwesterly line of lot 20, 31.12 feet to the most Westerly corner of said Lot 20 and the point of beginning, be and the same is hereby ordered accepted and recorded.

DEED OF RIGHT OF WAY SILVERADO CANNON ROAD

County of Orange)as WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Orange County, California, to widen and improve a portion of that certain highway commonly known as SILVERADO CANYON ROAD, in the Fourth Road District; and

WHEREAS, the necessary Right of Way for said widening and improvement is sore particularly described as follows, to-wit. Approved as to Description Jan.25, 1947

An irregular shaped parcel of land lying Northerly of and adjacent to the Right of Way for Silverado Canyon Road as shown on a Map of Tr 't No.1167, recorded in Book 36, Pages 41 and 42, Miscellaneous Maps, Records of Orange County, California, and being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most masterly corner of Lot 20 said Tract No.1167, and running themse Westerly, along the Northeasterly line of the Right of Way of Silverado Canyon Road as shown on said Map of Tract No.1167, 3.49 feet to a point of reverse curvature and the beginning of a curve consave Southwesterly and having a radius of 144.95 feet; thense, Northwesterly along said curve through a central angle of 31° 36' 00", 80.03 feet to a point; a radial line to said curve at said point bears N. 23° 05' 00" E., thence, leaving said curve 8.66° 55' 00" E. 99.66 feet to a point in the Northwesterly line of said Lot 20, which said point is distant Masterly, measured along said Northwesterly line, 31.12 feet from the most Westerly corner of said Lot 20; thence, S. 64° 35' 33" W. along said Northwesterly line of Lot 20, 31.12 feet to the most Westerly corner of said Lot 20 and the point of beginning.
