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It appearing to the Court that plaintiffs have paid to the defendants entitled thereto the total amount of just compensation provided for by Judgment in Condemnation;

It further appearing to the Court that pursuant to an order for prejudgment possession, plaintiff Orange County Water District was authorized to take possession of the real property described in its complaint in action No. 41-01-36 as Parcel I on November 1, 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the real property located in the County of Orange, State of California, described in action No. 41-01-36 and in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and by reference incorporated herein, shall be condemned in fee simple absolute to plaintiff Orange County Water District for public use, to wit: for the construction, completion, operation, and maintenance of water spreading grounds and improvements and to replenish and augment the underground water basin within plaintiff's district, and for such related public uses as may be authorized by law. The foregoing taking by plaintiff Orange County Water District in action No. 41-01-36 shall be subject to the hereinafter described easement condemned by plaintiff County of Orange in action No. 40-88-31, and subject to the easement for slope and drainage purposes vested in the County of Orange by deed recorded January 18, 1979, in Book 13005, Page 1012, Official Records of Orange County, California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a perpetual easement for slope and drainage purposes in the real property located in the County of Orange, State of California, described in action No. 40-88-31 as Parcel Z5-179 and in Exhibit "B" attached hereto, and by reference incorporated herein, shall be condemned to plaintiff County of Orange against Defendant Ruth A. Sussdorff, Defendant Sully-Miller Contracting Company (by reason of a Disclaimer having been filed by said Defendant in Orange County Superior Court Case No. 40-88-31) and against Defendants Conrock Company, Consolidated Rock Products and Calmat Company (by reason of a Disclaimer having been filed by Calmat Company, a corporation, for itself, and as successor in interest to Conrock Company and Consolidated Rock Products in Orange County Superior Court Case No. 40-88-31) for public use, to wit: for the maintenance of Villa Park Road at Santiago Creek, and for such related public uses as may be authorized by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a certified copy of this order be recorded in the offices of the County Recorder of the County of Orange, State of California, and thereupon fee title to the real property described in Exhibit "A" shall vest in plaintiff Orange County Water District subject to the easement for slope and drainage purposes vested in the County of Orange by Deed recorded January 18, 1979, in Book 13005, Page 1012, Official Records of Orange County, California; and a perpetual easement for slope and drainage purposes on the real property described in Exhibit "B" shall vest in plaintiff County of Orange, and all liens, leaseholds, and other encumbrances of whatsoever kind and nature on said real property are hereby cancelled, extinguished and terminated, and the taxes and tax liens, the lien of the County of Orange for general and special taxes, penalties and costs thereon shall be terminated, cancelled and extinguished as to that portion arising on and after November 1, 1983 (the effective date of possession in case No. 41-01-36 as specified
