REPORTED DESTROYED (SEE DATE IN DESTROYED BOX) - ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION BEING: FROM PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY GO ABOUT 0.4 MILE NORTHERLY ALONG THE WEST LEVEE OF THE SANTA ANA RIVER (OR GO SOUTH FROM HAMILTON ST. BRIDGE ABOUT 1 MILE) TO A LARGE CONCRETE VAULT ON WEST SLOPE OF WEST LEVEE HAVING CHAIN LINK FENCE AROUND IT REACHING WITHIN 2 FT. OF THE TOP OF LEVEE, FENCE IS 9.5 FT. WIDE NORTH-SOUTH AND 16 FT. EAST-WEST, DUE EAST FROM NORTH EDGE OF HUGE DOMED-TOP TREATMENT TANK 300 FT. TO THE WEST, MONUMENT IS 2.2 FT. SOUTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 9.5 FT. BY 16 FT. FENCE, 261 FT. WEST OF THE TOP OF A PAVED EAST SLOPE OF THE LEVEE, 1.1 FT. WEST OF AN ORANGE COUNTY SURVEY PADDLEBOARD, 14.5 FT. EAST OF THE CHAIN LINK FENCE WHICH IS ALONG THE TOE OF SLOPE, ABOUT 1.2 FT.
