MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE SANTA ANA RIVER AND THE GARDEN GROVE BOULEVARD OVERCROSSING, 36.1 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF GARDEN GROVE BOULEVARD AND 0.2 FT. WESTERLY OF A 4 FT. HIGH CHAIN LINK FENCE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE BRIDGE DECK.
