DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3E-82-71", SET IN THE SOUTHERLY CORNER OF A 4 FT. BY 11 FT. CONCRETE CATCH BASIN. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF IRVINE BOULEVARD, 0.1 MILES NORTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BROWNING AVENUE, 42 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF IRVINE BOULEVARD AND 9 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE SOUTHERLY CORNER OF A 6 FT. HIGH CHAIN LINK FENCE AROUND A FLOOD CONTROL CHANNEL. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
