MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF THE ATCHINSON/TOPEKA/SANTA FE RAILWAY, AT THE IRVINE SUBSTATION LOCATED AT 15215 BARRANCA, 54 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE BLUE SAFETY LINE ALONG THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF THE TRACKS, 150 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF MILE POLE #185 AND OCS CARSONITE MARKER 1 FT. NORTHERLY. MONUMENT IS SET 0.2 FT.
