REPORTED DESTROYED (SEE DATE IN DESTROYED BOX) - ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION BEING: DESCRIBED BY NATIONAL GEODETIC SURVEY 1955 1.4 MILES SOUTHEAST ALONG THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY FROM THE STATION AT SANTA ANA, AT THE CROSSING OF RITCHIE STREET (CROSSING 176.8), 30 FT. WEST OF THE CENTERLINE OF RITCHIE STREET, 25.5 FT. NORTHWEST OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE CONCRETE OF THE CONCRETE FOUNDATION SUPPORTING THE CROSSING SIGNAL, 18.7 FT.
