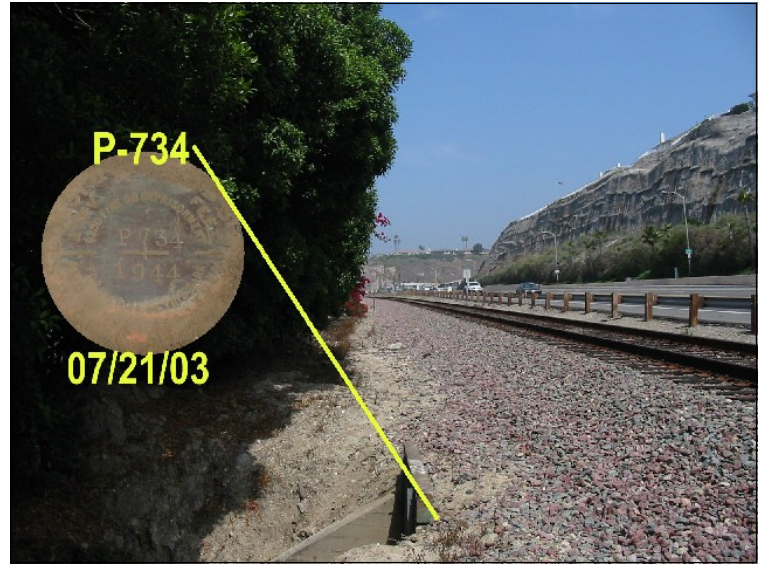

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "P 734 1934", SET IN THE SOUTHERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHWESTERLY SIDE OF EL CAMINO REAL, 0.35 MILES SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF CAMINO CAPISTRANO, 51.2 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF EL CAMINO REAL AND 212.6 FT. SOUTHERLY OF MILE POST #203. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE HEADWALL.
