DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "P 785 1946", SET IN THE NORTHERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL FOR A SMALL CULVERT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF THE ATCHINSON/TOPEKA/SANTA FE RAILWAY, 452 FT. SOUTHERLY ALONG THE RAILWAY FROM MILE POST 190, 12 FT. WESTERLY OF THE WESTERLY RAIL ALONG THE RAILWAY AND 0.4 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG THE RAILWAY FROM THE OVERCROSSING OF LA PAZ ROAD. MONUMENT IS SET 1 FT. BELOW THE LEVEL OF THE TRACKS.
