DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZE DISK STAMPED "P 98 1932", SET VERTICALLY IN THE WEST SIDE OF A BLOCK "WELLS FARGO" BUILDING. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHEASTERLY PORTION OF THE INTERSECTION OF GLASSELL STREET AND CHAPMAN AVENUE, 15 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE BUILDING AND 1 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE MOST NORTHERLY PILLAR. MONUMENT IS SET 3.5 FT. ABOVE THE SIDEWALK.
