DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USC&GS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "U 130 1932", SET IN THE WESTERLY END OF THE SOUTHERLY ABUTMENT FOR A RAILWAY BRIDGE OVER TRABUCO CREEK. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE BRIDGE, 6 FT. WESTERLY OF THE WESTERLY RAIL ALONG THE RAILWAY, 0.2 MILES NORTHERLY OF MILE POLE #196 AND 2.1 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE SOUTHERLY END OF THE ASPHALT CATWALK ALONG BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS SET 1.0 FT. BELOW THE RAILWAY.
