REPORTED DESTROYED (SEE DATE IN DESTROYED BOX) - ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION BEING: - RECOVERY NOTE BY NATIONAL GEODETIC SURVEY 1989 2.5 KILOMETERS (1.55 MILES) SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY (STATE HIGHWAY 1) FROM THE JUNCTION OF BEACH BOULEVARD (STATE HIGHWAY 33) IN HUNTINGTON BEACH, SET IN THE CENTER OF THE SOUTH ONE OF FOUR 3 FT. HIGH CONCRETE BASES FORMERLY SUPPORTING A TOWER, 205 FT. NORTHEAST OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE NORTHBOUND LANE OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, 10.4 FT. SOUTHEAST OF THE EAST CORNER OF A 7 FT. BY 7 FT. CONCRETE BLOCK PROJECTING 4 FT. ABOVE THE GROUND, 2 FT. LOWER THAN THE HIGHWAY. NOTE-- THE STAMPING HAS BEEN OBLITERATED, AND THE 9 OF 1945 IS ALL THAT IS LEGIBLE.
