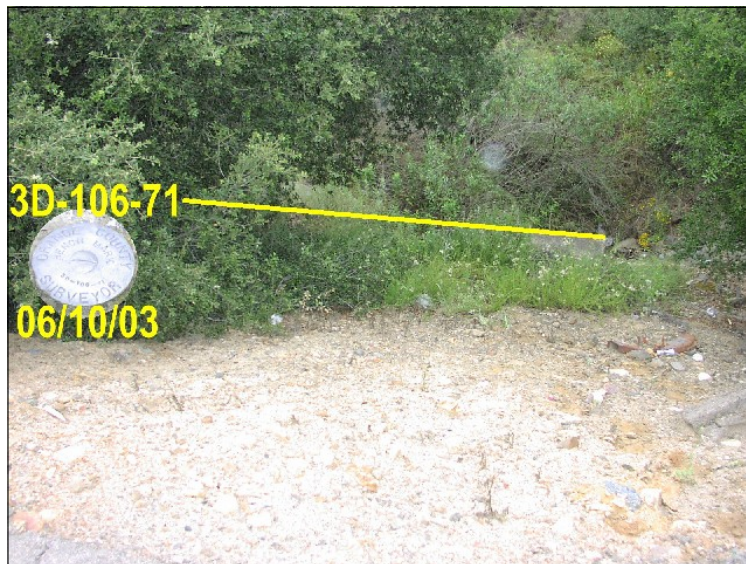

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3D-106-71", SET IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A CONCRETE BOX CULVERT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD, 1.15 MILES NORTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF MODJESKA CANYON ROAD AND 61 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD. MONUMENT IS SET 20 FT. BELOW THE SURFACE OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD AT THE BOTTOM OF A STEEP SLOPE.
