DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3D-112-71", SET IN THE MIDDLE OF A CONCRETE WINGWALL FOR A BOX CULVERT UNDERCROSSING OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD, 2.1 MILES NORTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE SILVERADO CANYON ROAD, 27 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD AND 5 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE SOUTHERLY END OF THE WINGWALL. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE DECK OF THE CONCRETE OVERCROSSING.
